1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- To co-ordinate, support and run school sport competitions both within and between the Aylsham Cluster Schools in liaison with the Head of PE at Aylsham High School.
- To support two key programmes and initiatives: The School Games and Change4Life Sports Clubs. *

2 PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work in partnership with the High School and Cluster Schools to compliment other initiatives which encourage a wide range of young people to participate in sport, such as Change4Life and sports clubs.
- Provide access to a range of alternative, modified and traditional competition formats in liaison with school PE Department and school sports coordinators.
- Co-ordinate, organise and run a range of alternative competitions following school guidance and protocols to engage young people in new spots opportunities.
- Maximise the impact of competitive school sport on young people and schools, in developing personal skills and contributing to the school ethos.
- Create sustainable school sport competitions both within and between schools
- Involve staff, parents, local people, young leaders and volunteers in the delivery of competitive sport
- Engage pupils in sport who are less active or who do not have equal access of opportunity to compete
- To work flexibly with the PE staff in developing student opportunities in accordance with the school timetable and curriculum requirements during lesson time, break time and extra-curricular time.
