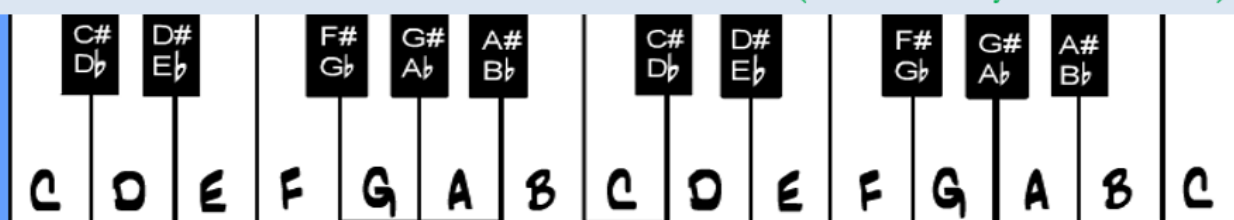


CHORDS REVISION

- A chord is 2 or more notes played **together** (usually 3 notes)
- Instruments that **can** play chords include; guitar, keyboard, ukulele, piano. (All instruments with strings & piano style black & white keys)
- Instruments that **cannot** play chords include; flute, trumpet, clarinet, basically anything you blow into except... BAGPIPES, HARMONICA, PANPIES
- Major chords = happy
- minor chords = sad

HOW TO WORK OUT CHORDS

1. Each chord **STARTS** with that letter.
2. **MAJOR** = Count 4 notes, then 3 (including black notes)
3. **MINOR** = count 3 notes then 4 notes (**TIP**= every other **letter**)

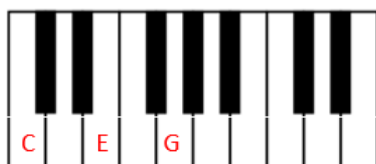


MAJOR = happy	minor = sad
C = C E G	Cm = C <u>Eb</u> G
D = D F# A	<u>Dm</u> = D F A
E = E G# B	<u>Em</u> = E G B
F = F A C	<u>Fm</u> = F Ab C
G = G B D	<u>Gm</u> = G Bb D
A = A C# E	<u>Am</u> = A C E
B = B D# F#	<u>Bm</u> = B D F#

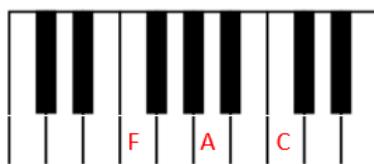
A tune using chords – 12 bar blues/ Hound Dog

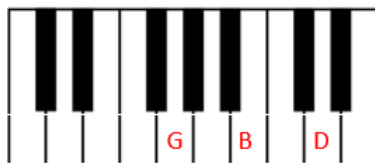
How to play these chords on the piano/keyboard:



C major chord

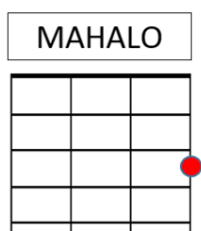


F major chord

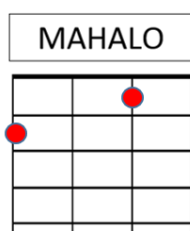


G major chord

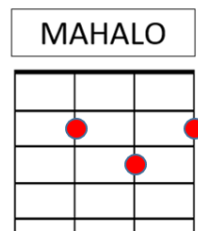
How to play these chords on the ukulele:
