Business and enterprise homework policy

The purpose of homework is to enhance student learning through the deepening of knowledge, improving achievement and to develop a student's study skills.

Homework is recognised as an aid to learning and will be set regularly. For Enterprise key stage 3, homework will be set every second lesson and will take approximately 20 minutes. In Business GCSE, 1 hour of homework is allocated for every teaching week. However, in the run up to examinations students are expected to personally manage their own revision programme, therefore this will add additional time and effort needed by students to complete this.

Homework will be meaningful and relevant to the intent and implementation of the department's curriculum plan.

Homework is an opportunity to recall previous learning, extend subject knowledge and to practice examination performance, to develop skills required for GCSEs.

Overtime tasks will be set that require learning of subject knowledge and recall of knowledge but can include research and completion of work not finished in lesson time. In Business GCSE each specification unit has its own examination preparation homework book, which contains a range of recall and exam practice questions. For all lessons recall quizzes are set on Google Classroom.

If homework is not completed by the set date, on the first occasion students will receive a warning and a further opportunity to hand in work. If this extended deadline is not met a detention will be issued and a negative yellow behaviour logged on SIMs.

If homework is not completed on 3 occasions parents/carers will be contacted. An afterschool detention will be issued for persistent failure to hand in work by the deadline.
