SIMS Student Registration for Year 7 Students – Website/App

SIMS Student is the student version of SIMS Parent, which allows students to access the same information as their parents/carers. *Please note, the SIMS Parent account email and invites will be sent out to parents/carers during week commencing 11th September.*

SIMS Student includes the following:

- Calendar
- SIMS Options
- Attendance
- Conduct achievements and behaviour
- Timetable
- Reports
- Messages
- Homework





SIMS Student further strengthens our communication with students by providing them with access to their own information and allowing us to send them messages from the school.

SIMS Student accounts

During the first few computing lessons, your child's teacher will complete some important tasks with them to register them for their electronic accounts and show them how to use the systems. One of these systems is SIMS Student. Your child's computing teacher will guide them through registering their SIMS Student account, how to log into the website and app and how to navigate the system. Students must use their alf.education email account for SIMS Student and not a personal email address.









Devices with parental controls

If your child's device has parental controls set up, you will need to download the SIMS Student app for them and then also give permission for them to use their school email account on their device in the parental control settings.

Accessing SIMS Student

Once students have activated their account, they can access SIMS Student via a website or an app. This means that your child will be able to access their own information via a smartphone, tablet or computer.

The SIMS Student app can be downloaded for free from either the Apple app store or the Google Play store on a smartphone or tablet. Please search for SIMS Student and then download the app onto your device.
