Over the next nine months, focussed revision outside of class will be very important for students to improve in their Language and Literature GCSEs.

Mock exam

On 1st November 2023 year 11 students will sit their English Literature Paper 1 mock examination.



For this paper the students must revise the following texts:

- **All students** to revise Romeo and Juliet by William Shakespeare for their first question.
- Most students to revise Frankenstein by Mary Shelley for their second question with the exception of the classes listed below.
- 11B7 (Mrs Elliott) and 11B6 (Mrs Collins) classes will instead write their second question on A Christmas Carol by Charles Dickens, as they studied this text in year 10.



If you have any queries about which questions your child is to revise, please double check with their class teacher.
