

Aylsham High School history department homework policy

2023-2024

Year 7

All students in year 7 will receive a termly homework booklet. The booklet will contain exercises to both test and apply core knowledge.

Two homework tasks will be set each half term period. This will allow students a period of two to three weeks to complete the task set. The tasks allocated should take students approximately 30-40 minutes to complete.

The homework booklet will have core knowledge included in the back. This will be a useful resource for students to access should they become stuck with a homework task. Some of the core knowledge will also be quizzed at the start of every lesson. Pupils are also encouraged to speak to their teacher or attend history club (every Wednesday lunch) to seek further support if needed.

Homework will be marked in class and students will be responsible for peer/self-marking. Teachers will set aside the time needed to feedback on homework and address concerns and misconceptions.

Year 8 & 9

All students in year 8 & 9 will receive a homework booklet for the academic year. The booklet will contain exercises to both test and apply core knowledge, and practice some disciplinary skills.

Two homework tasks will be set each half term period. This will allow students a period of three to four weeks to complete the task set. The tasks allocated should take students approximately 30-40 minutes to complete.

The homework booklet will have knowledge organisers included in the back. This will be a useful resource for students to access should they become stuck with a homework task. Some of the core knowledge will also be quizzed at the start of every lesson. Pupils are also encouraged to speak to their teacher or attend history club (every Wednesday lunch) to seek further support if needed.

Homework will be marked in class and students will be responsible for peer/self-marking. Teachers will set aside the time needed to feedback on homework and address concerns and misconceptions.

Year 10

All students in year 10 will receive a homework booklet for the academic year. The booklet will contain exercises to both test and apply core knowledge, and practice some disciplinary skills as appropriate. There will be a variety of tasks allocated for each topic covered in year 10.

Each task sheet should take approximately 45 minutes to complete, and additional time should be made to learn core knowledge in readiness for the tasks. Some of the core knowledge will also be quizzed at the start of every lesson.

Students will cover 3 topics in year 10, as listed below.

- Medicine through time
- British sector of the Western Front
- Anglo-Saxon and Norman England

Homework will be set on a fortnightly basis. This will allow students a period of two weeks to complete the task set.

The homework booklet will have core knowledge included in the back. This will be a useful resource for students to access should they become stuck with a homework task. Year 11

Each task sheet should take approximately 45 minutes to complete, and additional time should be made to learn core knowledge in readiness for the tasks. Some of the core knowledge will also be quizzed at the start of every lesson

Students will cover 2 topics in year 11, as listed below.

- Super-power relations and the Cold War
- Weimar and Nazi Germany

Homework will be set on a fortnightly basis. This will allow students a period of two weeks to complete the task set.
