Applications to college and sixth form

I am writing to remind you all about college applications for your child in year 11. It's great that many of our students have now applied, and have even had interviews, and received conditional offers.

However, if your child has **not** yet applied to college and/or sixth form, or would like to make further applications, it is vital that these applications be made as quickly as possible, ideally in the next week or so, and by the Christmas holidays (20 December) at the absolute latest. Some colleges will close their applications quite soon (e.g. Reepham on 8 December and Notre Dame on 18 December). At City College, courses fill on a first-come, first-served basis and popular courses will be nearing capacity, or even full, by now.





We recommend that, in most cases, applications be made using Help You Choose – www.helpyouchoose.org – as we have pre-populated this with a lot of information required for applications, including target grades. It also enables us to check and track applications. Notre Dame is an exception as they request all applications be made via their own website.









Other key reminders are:

- All students must apply to college, even if an apprenticeship is their preferred route. An
 apprenticeship cannot usually be guaranteed so all students need a college place, even if
 this is just a fall back option. We will have an apprenticeship evening for students and
 parents/carers, in school, on Tuesday 6 February 2024, at 6pm. Please save the date if this
 is of interest.
- Students should be aspirational but realistic about their choices, based on the target grades, and college entrance requirements. It is a good idea to have a 'Plan B' option at a different college, if there is any possibility of missing entry requirements for their first choice.
- City College, Paston and Easton interview for all courses. However, they will only interview
 and make a conditional offer for ONE course (or a programme of A Level study), unless
 instructed otherwise. So, if a student has applied for multiple courses at the same college,
 they need to make sure that they have specified on their application the correct order of
 preference so that they are interviewed for their <u>first choice</u> course. If in doubt, students
