

AHS Drama Drama Homework Policy & Key Dates



Homework at KS3 will require students to focus on and engage with the core knowledge of the curriculum. This may be through short form quizzes or short written responses to the theatre seen in lesson. As we reshape the curriculum students will begin to see a consistent frequency to when and what types of homework are set.

Homework in Drama will also look to provide cultural capital opportunities, therefore students might be asked to watch a piece of theatre on a streaming platform such as 'Drama Online' which they will be given access to.

Homework at GCSE is designed to feed directly into the success of students and their studies for GCSE Drama. The homework will strive to ensure that students not only make progress but will make them curious theatre makers and performers. All homework set will be purposeful and feed either directly into lessons and/ or the course outcomes.



Homework will be set every week and should total **approx. 1 hour a week**. Students will notice that during Autumn 1 they will have homework's that vary and differ in style and type. This is due to the nature of the component they are studying that equates to 40% of their overall result.

Homework students may expect to have:

Rehearsal at a break or lunch, core knowledge revision and test, research tasks, short written responses and final write up of NEA essays.
