OCR Cambridge Nationals Health and Social Care Course Guidelines

I am writing to you as it has been confirmed that your child has gained a place on the OCR Cambridge Nationals health and social course as part of their option programme for the academic year 2019-2020.

For the next academic year we will be delivering the OCR Cambridge Nationals Levels 1 and 2 in health and social; these courses involve an hour long exam. Further details of these courses are available from the Aylsham High School website under the options tab. We know students will work their hardest to achieve the results that they are capable of and we are keen to support them in doing this.

The following units will be covered:

- R021 - Essential values of care with individuals in care settings.
- R022 - Communicating and working with individuals in health, social care and early years settings.
- R027 - Creative activities to support individuals in health, social care and early years settings.
- R029 - Understanding the nutrients needed for good health. The cooking for this unit will take place in rooms 11 and 12 on the following evenings: Tuesday 24 and Thursday 26 September 2019. Your child must attend one of these sessions to cook their chosen meal to gain marks for their course work.

I would like to take this opportunity to outline the department's expectations of your child's responsibilities throughout their year as part of the health and social option programme.

- As health and social is a one year course deadlines are paramount, so any support you are able to give your child will be really helpful. In the event of absence it is advisable for students to contact their subject teacher to obtain any missed work.
- We would encourage students to start keeping up to date with current news events as these are referred to in examples of teaching. Newspapers and news bulletins are fantastic ways to see what is happening in the health and social environment and to embed specific subject knowledge.
