## **AHS Visit to Bletchley Park – Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2026**

I am writing to inform you of an exciting opportunity for members of the Aylsham High School GCSE Computing, ICT vocational award groups and Year 8 students. We have organised a visit to Bletchley Park, the home of the code breakers.

We will have a learning session on Interception to Intelligence: Battle of the Atlantic and a tour of Bletchley Park.

We will also have the opportunity to explore Bletchley Park exhibitions and historic buildings.

We will be travelling by coach from Aylsham High School to Bletchley Park in Buckinghamshire.

We will depart Aylsham High School at 6.45am from the back carpark. Your child must be at Aylsham High School by 6.30am, and it is their responsibility to ensure that they are there in plenty of time. We are scheduled to arrive back at Aylsham High School in the back carpark between 5.30pm and 6.00pm (this is a guide time and may change due to travel interruptions).

Students are able to wear their own clothes for the trip. We would ask that they adopt a smart/casual appearance, remembering they will be doing a lot of walking so sensible footwear is recommended, also bringing a rain proof jacket in case of wet weather.

Students will need to bring a packed lunch and a water bottle, please indicate on the consent form if your child is entitled to a free school meal and a packed lunch will be provided by the school.

Priority will be given to those studying GCSE computing and ICT vocational award groups.

There are 100 places available on this trip, so if numbers interested exceed this, places will be allocated using a random selection process.
