## ARRIVALS

The drive down to Mannington Hall is perfect for a grand entrance and promises of stylish arrivals in/on a variety of modes of transport abound. **As in previous years, we are awarding a prize for the most original, inventive or notable arrival.**

We would ask that your driver arrive at the **Top Gate** by the Glamping Site & is guided by our Traffic Control Team down the drive. Passengers can then alight at the bottom of the drive at the given spot, where their photograph will be taken with their vehicle before they join the other Guests. **Vehicles then to move on round, as directed, to leave by the bottom gate** to allow the next arrival their moment in the spotlight. There will be plenty of opportunity for parents and friends to take photographs and enjoy the arrivals of the **Class of 2026.**

**We would respectfully ask parents who are not bringing their child to the Prom, but who wish to see the arrivals, to be directed by our Traffic Team to the car-parking area provided at the Top Gate, so that parents' cars do not clog up with the vehicles of Prom guests. Parents are welcome to arrive any time from 6.00 pm to ensure they are there in good time to see their child in their full splendour. We would also ask that parents and friends stay on the lawn areas to allow the safe passage of vehicles.**

**\*Refreshments will be available for parents and guests to purchase as they watch the arrivals, should they wish to do so.**

## PROGRAMME

Arrivals are between **7.00 pm** and **8.00pm**. As Guests arrive we would ask them to be directed by our team of Flunkeys over the bridge spanning the moat for their **Welcome Drinks** and so that they have an excellent vantage point to enjoy the arrivals of others, not forgetting to pick up a Lucky Numbered Programme en route. These programmes contain their supper vouchers and other details for the evening. The photos will be taken on arrival, others from throughout the evening and a video will be available for download after the event. A link to the photos will be published for this. After Guests have partaken of their Welcome Drinks and everyone has arrived, they will make their way back across the bridge over the moat to the Marquee.

There will be dancing to our Connections DJ's set-list before a **hot Dirty Fries Supper** courtesy of **Bucket List** is served from approximately **8.45 pm**. (**Vegetarians, vegans and other dietary requirements are catered for**). The evening will continue with more dancing, music, chocolate fountain and other entertainment, until about **10.45 pm** when a **Firework Display** will herald guests being offered a glass of non-alcoholic fizz to join the Headmaster in toasting the departing year at **11.00 pm**. The **Prom 2026 King, Queen, Prince & Princess** will be announced and the prize draw drawn and other prizes awarded. The evening will be rounded off by a **Last Dance** at **11.45 pm**, giving a further quarter of an hour for tearful farewells and sorrowful partings before Cinderellas and Princes Charming have to leave the Hall at **MIDNIGHT.**
