Year 11 Celebration Day – Friday 19th June 2026

This year we will hold the year 11 celebration day on Friday 19th June. This event will allow us to celebrate, with your child, their time at Aylsham High School. At this point your child will have completed all of their exams.

On this day, students should attend school at the normal time. It will be a non-uniform day for year 11 students only. Students will meet in the dining room at 8.50am for registration followed by a celebration assembly running in to period 2. Students will attend tutor time as normal. After break there will be an early buffet lunch for all year 11 students, provided by the school.

At approximately 12.15pm we will transport year 11 students to the Hollywood Bowl, Riverside, Norwich for a couple of hours ten pin bowling, departing Norwich at 2.30pm to return for their usual transport home. Please note open-toe shoes/sandals/crocs are not permitted for safety reasons. The bowling alley does not provide bowling shoes, so suitable closed-toe shoes must be worn.

In past years a number of students have made further plans for the evening and have requested to remain in Norwich to return home later through private arrangements. We are happy to accommodate this arrangement, **however students can only remain in Norwich with your written consent on the Google consent form. You will be responsible for their wellbeing once the coach departs back to school.**

The total cost of the bowling trip and the transport is £14.00, payable via ParentPay by Monday 1st June. If your child receives free school meals some financial support may be available for this trip, please contact the finance department if this is something you would like to discuss.

For coach travel students can book seats with friends. Coach lists will be displayed in my room (23) and students can access these at breaktime or lunchtime to pick their space. If students do not choose a seat by Friday 5th June, they will be allocated one by me.

We are looking forward to celebrating on this day with our wonderful year 11 students and hope it provides a memorable afternoon with their classmates of the class of 2026.
