# Virtual Work Experience and Online Career Insight Opportunities

# What is virtual work experience?

Virtual (online) work experience provides young people with the opportunity to gain an insight into the workplace remotely, usually using online conferencing software such as Teams or Zoom. Most virtual work experiences range from half a day to one week, but some may have regular sessions over a longer time period.

## What's involved?

Experiences vary but most will include content such as: pre-recorded videos on what it's like to work in that organisation or job sector, virtual tours, live Q&A sessions, online meetings with a mentor, individual or group project work and networking opportunities.

# What are the benefits?

- Virtual work placements are open to everyone, regardless of location.
- Most virtual work experience placements are free, and you won't have to worry about travel expenses. There are also some paid opportunities – which can be costly, although bursaries are sometimes available for eligible students.
- Remote working is likely to be important for most businesses in the future. Learning how to work online will be a valuable skill for the modern workplace.
- Experience can be great for applications to college, university, apprenticeships or employment.
- It can help you decide if a career area is right for you or not.
- It's an opportunity to develop and practice some employability and career management skills such as: making applications, interviews, networking, communication, time management, presentation skills.

#### Safeguarding

- Be sure to check the company's credentials thoroughly by visiting their website and social media.
- Only provide personal information on the application form which is absolutely essential.
- It is best to use your school email address rather than your personal one.
- Most companies will have age guidelines for suitability, but if not, do make sure it's age appropriate.
- Make sure you tell Mrs Durand (School Careers Adviser) and your parents/carers that you are engaging with the programme.

#### Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, Dentistry, other Health and Social Care

Medicine

Brighton and Sussex Medical School

For aspiring medical students, this virtual work placement introduces students to the NHS and the roles and skill sets of six different medical specialists.

Premed Projects (paid)

Suitable for students aged 14-19 who are interested in biology, science, healthcare and medicine. View live videos within the operating theatre, download worksheets, watch interviews with healthcare professionals and receive tips and advice on applications.

Observe GP: Virtual Medical Work Experience

For students aged 16+. Programme of interactive virtual experience created for the purpose of giving every medical applicant a fair chance at gaining work experience.

• Doc Talk (paid)

A five-day virtual work experience, which has been designed to simulate a clinical hospital placement. Cost from £22.00
