Dear Parent/Carer

Results Day 2021

I hope that your families are well at this time.

As I am sure you are already aware, the GCSE examination results day is Thursday 12th August.

The arrangements for the collection of results will maintain a focus on minimising social interactions in order to keep everyone as safe as possible. The government are expecting there to be high numbers of positive COVID-19 cases during the summer and we want to protect students, parents and staff. I appreciate that this level of approach may mean that we taking a more careful attitude than the national guidelines require at this time. As a community, we have worked hard during the last 18 months to keep everyone as safe as possible and we would like to maintain this on results day.

As in previous years, results day will be staggered by year group. Therefore, your child will be required to attend school at a particular time based on their year group. We ask that you arrive between the times shown below:

- Class of 2021 – 9.30am – 11.00am
- Class of 2022 (new year 11) – 11.00am - 12.00pm
- Class of 2023 (new year 10) – 12.00pm - 1.00pm

If you have children in multiple year groups then, to help reduce the number of visits to school on this day, it is possible to collect the results for all siblings in one visit. In this situation we ask that all results are collected in the time slot for your eldest child. To help with our organisation we will only have the results for each year group available at the times shown above with the exception of siblings. Unfortunately, we will not be able to share results with you for other year groups if you arrive at an earlier time.

Arrangements on site

To help the morning run smoothly, we would ask you to be aware of the arrangements outlined below.

Please use the rear car park, accessed via Bure Meadows estate, when arriving at school. Please park in the parking bays so that the outer edge of the car park remains clear.

We are keen to organise the collection of results in as safe a manner as possible. This means that there will be collection points located around the car park with student results grouped alphabetically by surname.
