GCSE Geography Coastal Fieldtrip

As part of the GCSE geography course students are required to understand fieldwork techniques and will be assessed on these in one of the final formal examinations.

This year the fieldwork will be carried out along a stretch of the North Norfolk coastline between Sheringham and West Runton. The focus of the trip will be on reviewing coasts knowledge which was originally learnt during lockdown as well as practising a variety of fieldwork techniques. The group will begin the day in Sheringham, before walking along the coastal path to be collected at West Runton.

The fieldtrip will take place on Tuesday 5 October 2021 during the normal school day, so no alternative transport arrangements need to be made. Students are not required to wear school uniform for this trip, but as the whole day involves working outside appropriate warm clothing must be worn. For safety reasons it is essential that students wear sensible footwear and may wish to bring wellington boots as well. Students must bring a packed lunch with them as there will be no opportunity to buy one whilst on the trip; please indicate on the consent form if your child is entitled to a free school meal and a packed lunch will be provided by the school canteen.

The voluntary contribution of £10.00 to cover transport costs should be made via ParentPay.
