Uniform expectation as the weather gets warmer

As the weather has started to get warmer the uniform expectations are returning back to 'normal'.

Over the past months we have shown compassion with regards to allowing students to wear layers of clothing around school due to the level of ventilation. As part of the Covid mitigations we have introduced CO2 monitors within classrooms and these have shown that the levels reached do not exceed the maximum levels in general use and that small amounts of ventilation help return them to normal. Therefore, we will be reducing the ventilation to keep classrooms warmer, which means that we can reintroduce uniform expectations as they were before Covid.

From Monday 14 March these are the uniform expectations

- **No** coats will be allowed to be worn in classes, however they will be allowed to wear them around the school building during transitions to and from lessons. This saves students carrying them.
- **No** non- school jumpers will be allowed to be worn.
- Students will be allowed to wear extra layers under their uniform, such as a vest or long-sleeve t-shirt under their shirt. They will not be permitted to have tops over their blazers or black jumpers.
- The only jumpers allowed will be blue v-neck along with their blazer over the top
- Year 11s should wear their black v-neck jumpers such as an extra layer under a shirt, as per our uniform policy.
