Iceland Tour 2023 - Expression of Interest

Following the success of our Iceland 2022 trip we are going to explore the possibility of organising an Iceland 2023 trip. The trip will provide students with many experiences to enhance their curriculum experiences in geography, science and history.

This trip is not normally offered annually. The 2023 trip is being planned as we had a great deal of interest in the 2022 trip. The 2023 trip will provide students who were unable to attend the 2022 with the opportunity to experience an Icelandic adventure. This means that the trip will be offered initially to students in year 10 as this will be their last opportunity to attend this trip with the school.

The tour will be for 4 nights and 5 days, departing 24th February 2023 and returning 28th February 2023. We have not yet costed the trip fully but would expect the final cost to be between £1100-1200. We have not yet finalised our itinerary but it will include:

- Transfers to and from the airport
- Return flights
- Coach travel in Iceland
- Accommodation and bedding
- All meals
- All planned itinerary excursions
- All optional activities e.g. Perlan observation deck and planetarium, Lava show, Fly Iceland Experience

We are hoping to accommodate as many students as possible on the trip. However, if numbers interested exceed the places available, places will be allocated to those who have previously expressed an interest in their child attending the Iceland Tour first, then a random selection process will be used to allocate any remaining places. Families will be notified of their child's place on the trip following the deadline on Friday 18th March. At this point, students selected will need to pay a deposit of £275 by Friday 25th March to secure their place on the trip. Flights will need to be booked soon after this date so it will be important that payments are made by the required date.

Once we have confirmed the list of students attending the trip we will write to families to share further key dates and information.
