Uniform updates from the summer term

We would like to inform you of a few updates regarding school uniform from the summer term which starts on Wednesday 20 April 2022.

Students will now be able to wear the blue AHS polo shirts along with their blazers for the whole of the summer term rather than only being allowed to wear them in the second half of the summer term as in previous years.

The other update is that knee length tailored or cargo shorts in dark grey or black can be worn by all students for the whole of the summer term. No cycling shorts or tight shorts are to be worn, shorts must be knee length. Shoes and socks will need to be worn with the shorts (students are allowed to wear black leather trainers with black soles and no other evident colours, markings or visible branding). Students not in correct footwear will be required to change into school plimsolls.
