Dear Parent/Carer,

Updated COVID-19 guidance from Friday 01 April 2022

We have received the following information from the Government, this is an extract from their guidelines:

- From Friday 01 April schools will no longer be recommending regular asymptomatic testing as we now know that Covid-19 presents a low risk of serious illness to most children and young people, and most of those who are fully vaccinated.
- From Friday 01 April adults with a positive Covid-19 test result will be advised to try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for five days, which is when they are most infectious. **For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.**

Here is an example:

Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday
Tests positive – isolate	Day 1 – isolate	Day 2 – isolate	Day 3 – isolate	Return to normal activities

- Unfortunately, we no longer receive lateral flow tests to issue to students.
