## Iceland Tour 2024

Following the success of our Iceland 2022 tour we are planning an Iceland Tour 2024. The trip will provide students with many experiences to enhance their curriculum experiences in geography, science and history.

This trip is being offered to students currently in years 7, 8 and 9. Based on previous years, we would expect the final group size to be around 40-50 students. The tour will be for 4 nights and 5 days, departing 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024 and returning 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024. We have not yet costed the trip fully but would expect the final cost to be between £1100-1200. We have not yet finalised our itinerary but it will include:

- Transfers to and from the airport
- Return flights
- Coach travel in Iceland
- Accommodation and bedding
- All meals
- All planned itinerary excursions e.g. Reynisfjara lava beach, Gullfoss, Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss waterfalls, Geysir, Thingvellir National Park and free time in Reykjavik.
- All optional activities e.g. Secret Lagoon, Perlan observation deck and planetarium, Lava show, Fly Iceland Experience, glacier walk, Hellisheidi geothermal power station and carbon capture plant.

We are hoping to accommodate as many students as possible on the trip. However, if numbers interested exceed the places available, places will be allocated to older students initially to ensure that they are able to experience this trip before they leave AHS. Any remaining places will then be allocated using a random selection process. Families will be notified of their child's place on the trip following the deadline of Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May. At this point, students selected will need to pay a deposit of £275 by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> June to secure their place on the trip. Flights will need to be booked soon after this date so it will be important that payments are made by the required date.

Once we have confirmed the list of students attending the trip we will write to families to share further key dates and information.
